# General Rules & Regulations

1. All participants must complete the registration form through the official website:

2. Incomplete submissions or missing fees will not be processed and participants will not be included in the official list.

3. The Google Form will be used for registration and submission of all the necessary data until January 9, 2026. The registration is only deemed final once all steps, including the completion of payment are completed.

4. The registration fee should be transferred to ANTHEA CALISTA, BCA 870-562-6142 with the receipt format: "Regis\_CompetitionName\_FullName/TeamName" (Example: Regis\_Badminton\_AaronCorneliusMayer).

5. A receipt will be sent to the participant's registered email once payment is confirmed.

6. The committee reserves the right to reject any requests for a refund of registration payment. The committee has the right to disqualify participants and/or teams who are proven to have falsified administrative documents or have submitted incomplete documents. Any attempts to fabricate or use someone else's student card data and photo will result in automatic disqualification.

7. All participants joining competitions must strictly adhere to the grade and year of birth requirement as per category/competition.

8. Primary Level participants are students enrolled in Elementary School (Born between 2013-2020).

9. Lower Secondary Level participants are students enrolled in Lower Secondary (Born between 2010-2014).

10. Upper Secondary Level participants are students enrolled in Upper Secondary (Born between 2007-2011).

11. Each participant and/or team is permitted to be accompanied by officials (teacher, coach, guardian, or parents) who will be given a separate nametag to wear around the competition perimeter. Officials will only be given a nametag if they have filled in their data in the registration Google Form.

12. The maximum number of officials per participant/team is specified in the competition e-invite.

13. If required, teacher supervisors must accompany participants and wear their school ID card at all times; absence will lead to disqualification.

14. At least 1 (one) representative per competition must attend the technical meeting at PENABUR Intercultural School - Secondary and Junior College Kelapa Gading. Only fully registered participants may join the technical meeting. The technical meeting will be held onsite on January 23, 2026. Details regarding the technical meeting will be given upon further notice in each competition's WhatsApp group. Failure to send a representative for each competition will result in the loss of walkout fee.

15. Bringing supporters to the "The PREMIERE: Nocturna Maris" event is permitted. However, people outside students and teachers from PENABUR Intercultural School - Secondary and Junior College Kelapa Gading and any officials who have no separate nametag (as stated in rule number 11 and 12) must purchase entry tickets of Rp 15.000 per person. The committee has the right to expel supporters who disrupt school order and security. Showing inappropriate/impolite behavior would directly lead to the disqualification of the participant/team they are supporting.

16. People outside of PENABUR Intercultural School - Secondary and Junior College Kelapa Gading and any officials with no separate nametag who would like to purchase either entry tickets or closing tickets are required to show their ID cards during registration.

17. Sportsmanship and honesty is expected to be upheld throughout the entirety of our event. Immediate disqualification sanctions will be given to participants who are deemed uncooperative in being sportsmanlike and honest.

18. All attitudes and behaviors that are deemed to disrupt the events will not be tolerated. The event committee has the full right to take firm action against accompanying supporters and team members, including teachers and coaches, who cause such uncondusive situations.

19. All participants are strictly prohibited from bringing non-related objects to the "The PREMIERE: Nocturna Maris" event such as cigarettes, vapes, sharp objects, and drugs. Smoking within PENABUR Intercultural School - Secondary and Junior College Kelapa Gading's premises will not be tolerated. Any object that is deemed dangerous and has the potential to cause nuisance will be confiscated by the committee. Confiscated items will be returned before the owner leaves the school premise. Participants/teams who do not follow these rules may be disqualified.

20. Any clothing spectators or participants wear must be appropriate to wear in a school environment. Any individuals wearing inappropriate clothing will not be allowed to enter the school premises, examples include but are not limited to: pants shorter than knees and crop tops.

21. The committee is not responsible for any negligence, damage, loss, accident, or health risk during the event.

22. Participants are required to arrive 1 (one) hour before the competition starts. If a participant arrives later than the respective maximum time set for each competition, the committee has the right to reject requests for additional time, AND immediately disqualify late participants.

23. Each competition has a minimum and maximum number of participants. If the maximum number of participants has been reached, then any registration filled afterward will be put on the waiting list. If the minimum number of participants is not reached, the committee has the right to cancel the competition.

24. Each participant must show and wear the nametag provided by the committee during the opening of "The PREMIERE: Nocturna Maris" before entering the entrance gate. If a participant cannot show the nametag, the committee has the right to:

- ask participants to pay Rp 50.000 for the nametag replacement.
- prohibit these participants from participating in the competition they are participating in.

25. Every participant must send at least 1 (one) representative from each school to attend the opening ceremony of "The PREMIERE: Nocturna Maris" in PENABUR Intercultural School - Secondary and Junior College Kelapa Gading's hall. The opening event will be conducted offline on Friday, 6th February 2026. The committee reserves the right to retain walkout fees if participating schools fail to send at least 1 (one) representative to attend the opening event of "The PREMIERE: Nocturna Maris".

26. The committee has the right to prohibit:

- participants who have been disqualified/lost in the competition from entering the school premises using a nametag that is no longer valid.
- anyone who causes discomfort and insecurity in the school environment.

27. Every participant is accountable for upholding order and cleanliness in the PENABUR Intercultural School - Secondary and Junior College Kelapa Gading's premise and is forbidden from causing property damage. Any property damage will be charged for replacement.

28. Outside food and drinks are prohibited. Only tumblers are allowed.

29. Participants must notify the committee before the technical meeting if they are unable to take part in the competition for any reason. Failure to inform the committee within the specified time may result in forfeiture of walkout and registration fees. The committee also reserves the right to disqualify participants who do not comply with this requirement.

30. The decisions of the jury/referee in all competitions are absolute and cannot be contested.

31. If a participant disagrees with the jury's decision, they may submit a written protest to the committee. The protest will only be considered valid if accompanied by a fee of Rp 350.000. However, the committee may reject a given protest once a thorough investigation has been conducted.

32. During "The PREMIERE: Nocturna Maris", the committee reserves the right to amend or adjust rules as necessary to ensure the smooth running of the event.

# BADMINTON

## COMPETITION DETAILS

1. Participants are required to abide by The PREMIERE 2026 General Rules and Regulations without exception.
2. Schools may have more than 1 (one) representative to participate in each event. However, each competitor or doubles pair may only join 1 (one) event. For example: Men's Doubles participant(s) cannot participate in Men's Singles.
3. The competition will follow the regulations of PBSI.
4. Each match will be played as best of 3 sets. The competition will use a single elimination/knockout system (*sistem gugur*).
5. Professional umpires and line judges will officiate all matches.
6. 3 shuttlecocks will be provided per match. Any additional shuttlecocks required must be paid for by the player at Rp 10.000 each. All participants must bring their own badminton rackets and any additional equipment they require.
7. Participants must arrive 20 minutes before their scheduled match and be ready to play. If a participant fails to respond after being called 3 times, they will be considered a walkout.
8. All participants must wear appropriate sportswear during matches. Doubles pairs must wear matching sportswear. Failure to comply will incur a fee of Rp 50.000.

9. Each school MUST bring at least 1 (one) official per participant or pair, one of whom must be a supervising teacher with a teacher ID card. If a supervising teacher is absent or not wearing a teacher ID card, the participant will be disqualified.

## RULES

1. Participants are required to abide by The PREMIERE 2026 General Rules and Regulations without exception.

1. Competitors have up to 15 seconds to inspect the cube before starting their solve.
2. The solve officially begins when the competitor removes both hands from the timer sensors after placing the cube on the mat.

### **SOLVING REGULATIONS:**

1. Competitors must start and stop the timer using both hands on the sensor. Failure to do so may result in penalties.
2. No external tools or aids are allowed during the solve. This includes lubricants, notes, or electronic devices.

1. A judge will oversee each solve. Any rule infraction - such as a false start, touching the cube before the timer begins, or moving the cube after the timer stops - may result in time penalties.
